The Timpanogos Chorale has stated they would like to separate from TAF and has asked to join the Harrington Center for the Performing Arts. The grant funds for the Timpanogos Chorale will be considered after such time that TAF can prove the existence of an adult choir and/or HC applies on behalf of the Timpanogos Chorale.

The Board has asked TAF for a more detailed information for the funding on their various programs. Therefore, after that information is received the Board will be able to give the recommendations to the Council.
