The 2020 Survey was open from November 30, 2020 to December 31, 2020. It was available primarily online, though physical copies were available at city facilities and mailed out to residents with their utility bill. The city received 1,712 responses, which represents about 5% of the population, or 20% of the households in the City. In each portion of the survey you will see "% Responded." This is the number of people, out of the 1,712 total responses, that responded to that particular question.





Top Reasons to Live in American Fork











How long do you plan to stay in AF?








Should the City explore fiber internet options?
