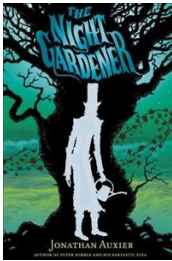


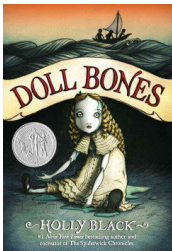
Small Spaces

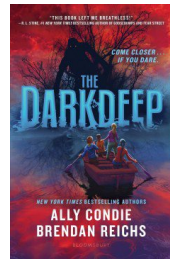
The Night Gardener

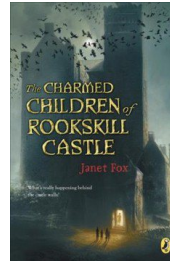
The Darkdeep

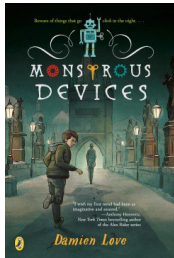

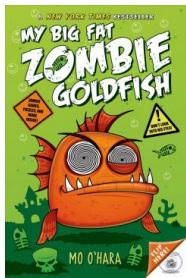

by Mo O'Hara

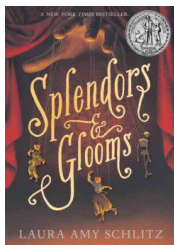

by J. Scott Savage

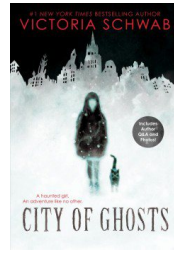

by Victoria Schwab

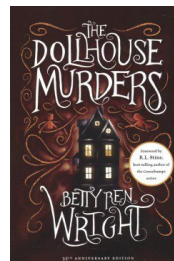

by Alvin Schwartz

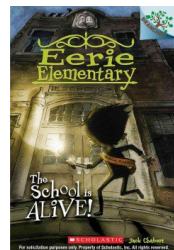
Tapped from the oral traditions of American folklore, these ghost stories and tales of weird happenings, witches, and graveyards have startling, funny, or surprising endings.

by Betty Ren Wright

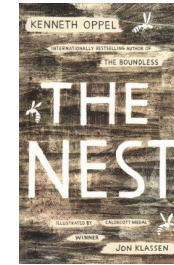
