

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-02-08R

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE PRESERVATION AND CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE NORTH UTAH COUNTY EQUESTRIAN PARK.

WHEREAS, Utah County in cooperation with State agencies and local municipalities developed the 37-acre North Utah County Equestrian Park;

WHEREAS, the Park received financial support from the State of Utah, Utah County, surrounding municipalities and other institutions in addition to donations, and contributions of time and materials by local jurisdictions and residents;

WHEREAS, the Park has been in operation since 2001, providing access to equestrian facilities, open space areas, trails, and park amenities, including an unmatched natural environment for the benefit of the residents of the County;

WHEREAS, the Park is a regional facility benefitting all residents of the County and surrounding communities;

WHEREAS, the Park was developed and improved in a true cooperative effort with the surrounding cities, as stated, at its opening in 2001;

WHEREAS, the Park is the only public equestrian facility in north Utah County and represents a limited area of available public open space and multi-use trail network; and

WHEREAS, input regarding the future use and maintenance of the Park requires public input and consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, the American Fork City Council resolves to give support for the preservation and continued operation of the North Utah County Equestrian Park to be maintained and open to the public without additional private commercial or residential development.


