NOTICE OF MANDATORY METER INSTALLATION

American Fork City Property Owner,

American Fork City has a pressurized irrigation system specifically designed for outdoor watering usage on landscape, lawns, and agriculture. In accordance with the 2019 Utah State legislative mandate that all cities meter their secondary water usage, American Fork City has been working to install pressurized irrigation (PI) water meters on all connections in the City. Your property is on the schedule for PI meter installation in the coming months.

Spring 2023 begins Phase 2 of the installation project, starting in the lower two-thirds of the City. All existing PI connections will be fitted with a water meter. American Fork has received Federally-matched grants, which will be used along with reserved City funds for this project. The citywide PI Meter Project will take several years to complete. There is no additional cost to residents or businesses for the meter installation and the existing flat rate structure will continue until all meters have been installed citywide and a new rate study is conducted based on usage.

The PI connection on your property will receive a PI meter as part of Phase 2. On the back of this letter, you can find a map of the City showing Phase 2 installation locations. The City-approved contractor installing meters is Hydro Vac Excavations, LLC.

The meter will be installed in the existing City PI utility service box. A section of the existing service line will be removed to accommodate the new meter. This requires the removal of any existing filter and/or hose bibb. The new meter will be installed with a transponder wire that attaches to the service box lid. Once the install is complete, you should not tamper with the service box lid. Doing so may damage the meter parts inside, which are City property. After installation, your landscaping will be restored.

If you want to install a hose bibb or any filter or valve on your PI service line, you will be responsible for installing those items on your property. No private installation should occur within the utility service box or on the street-side of the service box preceding the meter.

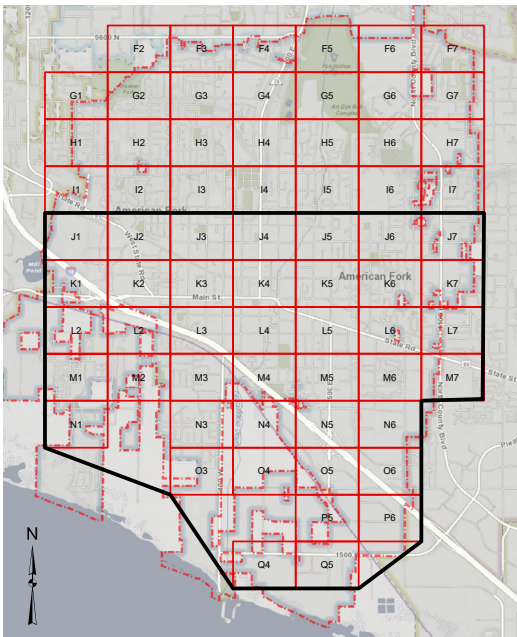

Phase 2



The City-approved contractor for Phase 2, Hydro Vac Excavations LLC., will be working in the PI service box and are allowed access on your property for installation purposes. Contact Hydro Vac , LLC. for any questions/concerns about the installation at (385) 465-4687.



The Process



Pressurized irrigation (PI) users will have a meter installed in the PI service box located on their property. The process typically takes 2-4 weeks. Here is what can be expected when a meter is installed:

- You will receive a written notice in advance of the meter installation on your property.
- Crews from Hydro Vac Excavation LLC. will clear the utility box of debris in preparation for meter installation.
- Hydro Vac crews will install a meter within the existing PI service box on your property. PI water service should only be shut off during the installation of the meter.
- The crew will restore the area as close as possible to pre-installation conditions.
