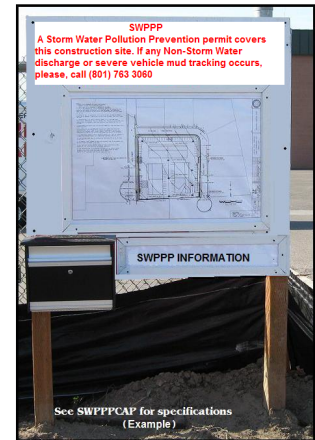

Section IV. Enforcement Actions and Penalties – AF City Ordinance 2010-06-16 Section 9 and 10

Corrective Action Notice

Whenever the City finds a Site Operator has violated a prohibition or failed to comply with a requirement of this permit, the Storm Drain Representative will order compliance by a written Corrective Action Notice to the responsible person.

Notice of Violation

A Notice of Violation will be issued by the Storm Drain Representative whenever the City finds a person has failed to comply with the requirements set on the Corrective Action Notice.

Stop Work Order

A Stop Work Order will be issued by the City whenever the City finds a Site Operator failed to comply with the Notice of Violation within the specified time and/or if there is Hazardous Material polluting the storm drain system or a spill.

Violation and Enforcement

Under the authority provided in the Utah Code, American Fork City declares that any person violating the provisions of this ordinance may be assessed a Class C Misdemeanor by the City Storm Drain Representative upon direction from the City Council or not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per day for each violation. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate violation. AF City Ord 2010-06-16 Section 10. (1)

Section V. Certification Statement

I understand that this SWPPP permit is required and will remain in effect until the entire project is stabilized, including re-vegetation and the Notice of Termination (NOT) has been filed and accepted by the City or the Utah State Division of Water Quality (DWQ). By signing this form, I am fully aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for known violations.

I understand that I will be subjected to random SWPPP inspections and that my responsibility for compliance with the terms of this Permit will extend until a Notice of Termination is submitted to the City and/or Utah State DWQ.
