The above applicant is hereby granted, subject to the regulations for the Control and Protection of City Streets Rights-of-Way, Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction, Specifications for Excavation on City Streets, General Safety Orders of the Industrial Commission, Safety Manual for Road and Bridge Construction, Instructions to Flagmen, the approved plans, and any special limitations set forth herein, permission for the purpose of installing the following utilities (Sec. 12.08020)

The work permitted herewith shall commence after receiving an approved permit and shall diligently be prosecuted to completion. The work shall be completed and all surfaces or objects restored on or before the specified date above. It is unlawful for any person having made an excavation in any street, whether under a permit or otherwise to fail, neglect, or refuse to restore such street to its normal condition. Street excavations shall have the surfacing replaced within three calendar days following completion of the excavation. (Sec. 12.08.030) Before work permitted herewith is commenced, the applicant shall notify the American Fork City Engineering Division. Commencement of said work is understood to indicate that the applicant will comply with all instructions and regulations of the American Fork City Engineering Division with respect to performance of said work, and the applicant will properly safeguard said work to prevent accident and shall hold American Fork City free and harmless from all damages arising out of all operations performed under this Permit.

If the applicant fails to comply with the American Fork Engineering Division regulations, specification, or instructions pertinent to this Permit, the City Engineer, or his/her duly authorized representative, may by verbal order suspend the work until the violation is corrected. If any gravel, dirt, or building material are left on the street with the City, it must be cleaned up within 48 hours. If the applicant fails or refuses to comply promptly, the City Engineer, or his/her authorized representative, may issue a written order stopping all or any part of the work. When satisfactory corrective action is taken, a start order will be issued.

Applicant shall 1)Notify all emergency personnel, adjacent businesses, residents and Alpine School District of any lane closures; 2)Provide adequate traffic control and 3)Call for inspection of all utilities, trench backfill and asphalt installation. TRENCHES MUST BE COVERED WITH A STEEL PLATE AND NOT LEFT OPEN OVERNIGHT. Concrete must be covered and heated, if required.

Applicant shall provide the following:

- \* A site plan showing cut location(s) with square footage and infrastructure installation including any handholes, manholes, and/or above-ground facilities
- \* A traffic control plan
- \* A performance guarantee in a minimum amount of two thousand dollars, plus five dollars for each square foot of replacement in excess of four hundred square feet or the anticipated roadway repair cost if greater as determined by the City Engineer (12.08.040.G). One half of the right-of-way excavation performance guarantee shall be released upon initial completion with the balance of not less than \$1,000 being held for one year as a improvement warranty.
